
Unless you "tune" your search, just one field needs to match the record to be in your results.

Name, location, estimated year of birth







Search Tip #3: Wildcards

Try wildcards with exact on names to find unusual spellings of names. Sm?th* matches Smith, Smyth, and Smythe. You must have at least 3 characters to use a wildcard.

 - Records returned = birth year 5, and birthdates + 102.



Search Tip #5: Lifespan Filtering


- Entering only a birth year

 - Records returned = birth year 5, and birthdates + 102.
- Entering only a death date
 - Assumes the person lived about 100 years.
 - Records returned = death year 105 to death year +2.



7. Is it possible that John Snavely in 1900 is Nicholas J L in 1880?	
8. Why is there so much space between Mollie V and Gordon?	
9. Did Oregon H get married between 1880 and 1900; how about Nicholas JL and Idella J	In 1900, we know that an Idella married a John Feazell in 1883, most likely in Smyth County
10. Are Nicholas and Molly the parents of Adam, William, Ferdinand, Susan, Alexander and Mary J?	
11. What is the relationship of Elizabeth Gross to the household?	
12. Did Elizabeth and Mary die or get married between 1850 and 1860?






